Polls will be open in Middletown Springs from 7 am - 7 pm at the Historical Society.

Reminder - you will be given three ballots (one for each Party) before entering the voting booth. Once inside the voting booth, decide which PARTY Ballot you want to vote. You can vote for candiates of ONLY 1 Party on only 1 ballot, or your vote will not count.
