
Dear Ms. Whitney:

Following Applicant Orchard Road Solar I, LLC's ("ORS") status letter to the Commission on September 21, 2018, ORS is pleased to submit the enclosed supplemental materials supporting relocation of the proposed Orchard Road Solar Project to the site previously discussed as "Alternative Site 2," located to the far east of the site parcel and across Orchard Road from the original proposed site. These materials include *Supplemental Testimony and Exhibits of Rod Viens, Dori Barton, Seth Goddard, and Mark Kane* confirming that the Project, as relocated on the current site, satisfies the applicable Section 248 criteria necessary for a Certificate of Public Good pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 248 and 219a. If helpful to the Commission, ORS would be happy to provide an updated Proposed Findings of Fact and Proposed CPG Order that includes this updated evidence.

It is ORS's understanding that the revised proposed Project, as supported by the enclosed materials, fully resolves the Neighbors' issues and concerns previously raised in this proceeding, but suggests that the Hearing Officer set a 21-day comment period on these materials for other parties to review as this is the standard time period for review/comment of application materials under Rule 5.110(C). With respect to adjoining landowners, as the Alternative Site is on the same parcel of land as the original site, ORS has confirmed that all adjoining landowners to the current site were notified of the proposed project at the time of the original application. Furthermore, as detailed in the testimony of Mr. Viens, ORS has reached out to the most proximate residences (aside from the host landowner) and is also sending a notice letter to all non-participating adjoiners to notify them of the change in project location (See Exhibit ORS-RV-10).
