3. Need Property Tax information for your Income Taxes?

Use the copy of the Property Tax bill that was mailed to you in August, or, if you're a new homeowner, use the copy that was provided to you at your closing.

Helpful hint: when you receive your new property tax bill for FY19/20 in August – hang on to it to use for next year's income taxes.

4. Dog Licenses:

Vermont State Law (20 V.S.A. 3581) requires that ALL dogs and wolf-hybrids six (6) months of age or older must be licensed by April 1 of each year. Call the Town Office if you aren't sure about the status of your dog's rabies certification. A 50% penalty on the original fee will be assessed for all registrations after April 1, 2019.

Hunting and Fishing Licenses

are available at the Town Office.

The Town receives \$1.50 for each license sold!!
