As you may have heard, the Middletown Springs Selectboard has appointed a group of volunteers to serve as a Building Committee. This committee is charged with researching all the issues surrounding construction of a new Town Office on the Parker Service Station site in the center of the village. Based on that research, the committee will make periodic recommendations to the Board of Selectmen who will then determine whether or not to act upon those recommendations. Along the way the Building Committee and Selectboard will be seeking input from town residents, as it is the voters who will make the decision about how the site is used.

There are many questions to answer and issues to explore include Brownfields requirements, funding sources, budget, site and building design, community input and support, scheduling, and others.

We have been hard at work for the past two months and have good news to report. One of our goals is to keep everyone informed as we move forward and Front Porch Forum is one of the tools we intend to use to do so. We will post periodic updates here and in the Magnet and are exploring other ways to keep you up to date.

Building Committee meetings are held on the first Wednesday and third Thursday of each month at 7:00 pm at the Town Office. These meetings are open to the public and you are welcome to attend.
