Facilities Questionnaire Results

The Selectboard received over **150 responses** to their facilities questionnaire. The response was strong and the comments many. Those comments have been posted, in their entirety, on the Town's website; find them by clicking the link called "Facilities Survey Data" on the left side, immediately below the photo. (Note: the first column is a serial number. Those beginning with C were submitted via computer; those with L submitted at the library; those with O submitted at the town office; and those with V submitted at Vicki's.) The portions of comments that specifically target individuals have been removed. Otherwise, they are direct transcriptions of what was written.

Which of the projects is the highest priority?

- 56% replied that the town office, though simplified and probably without the library, was the highest priority
- 24% replied that the town yard (garage, salt/sand, transfer station) was the highest priority
- 14% replied that the firehouse was the highest priority
- 6% did not choose a top priority

Which projects should be supported at all? (Calculated by counting the number of times a project was chosen as top priority plus the number of times it was chosen individually as a second priority plus the number of responses who said that all three should be done.)

- 93% of responses supported the town office
- 76% of responses supported the town yard
- 51% of responses supported the firehouse

The Selectboard is still working their way through the results and comments, and their implications. They will determine in the next month what measures (if any) they will put on the Town Meeting ballot.
